

## Communion Antiphon



## Canticle of Revelation



- Choir: 2 for the <u>mar</u>riage of the Lamb has come, †
  and his bride has **máde** herself **read**y; \*
  to her it has been granted to be clothed with fine *lìnen*, **bright** <u>and</u> pure."
- St. John: 3 Then I <u>saw</u> heaven opened, and **thére** was a **white** horse! \* Its rider is called *Fàithful* <u>and</u> True.
- St. John: 4 He is <u>clothed</u> in a **róbe** dipped **in** blóod, \* and his name is <u>càlled</u> The **Word** <u>of</u> God.
- St. John: 5 On his <u>robe</u> he **hás** a **name** inscribed, \*
  "King of kings and **Lord of** lords."
- St. John: 6 Then I <u>saw</u> a new heaven and a new èarth; †
  and I saw the holy city, the **néw** Je**ru**salem, \*
  coming down out of heaven from God, ' prepared as a bride adorned *fòr her* **hus**band.
  - Christ: 7 "See, the <u>home</u> of God is among mortàls. †
    He will **dwéll** with them **as** their God; \*

they will be his peoples, 'and God himself will be with them;

Christ: 8 he will wipe every tear from their èyes. †

Déath will be no more; \*

mourning and crying and pain will be no more, ' for the first things have passed away."

And the one who was seated on the throne said, \* St. John (to the comma), then Christ: "See, I am màking all things new."

10 Then he said to me, "It is done! † St. John (to the comma), then Christ:


I am the Alpha and the Omega, the beginning and the end. \* To the thirsty I will give water as a gift from the spring of the water of life."
